## **Best Practice-I: Empowering Women**

#### **Objectives of the Practice**

At S.M.S.L. Government College Julana (Jind), the Women's Cell aims to empower young women by fostering gender sensitivity, leadership skills, and social awareness. The objectives include:

- 1. Creating social awareness about gender equity and addressing challenges faced by women.
- 2. Empowering young women through skill development, leadership opportunities, and education.
- 3. Providing platforms for students to voice their thoughts and share experiences.
- 4. Enhancing legal and personal awareness on issues like health, safety, and gender equality.

#### The Context

The institution strives to provide a safe and inclusive environment where young women can develop confidence, acquire essential skills, and achieve their aspirations.

#### **The Practice**

- 1. **Skill Enhancement Activities:** The Women's Cell regularly organizes skill-based programs, including workshops on self-defense, Financial Education for Young Citizen. These initiatives equip students with practical skills for self-reliance and economic independence.
- 2. Cultural and Creative Competitions: Events such as Mehndi competitions, rangoli making, essay writing, and slogan writing competitions provide opportunities for students to showcase creativity, build confidence, and engage actively in campus life.
- 3. Awareness Programs and Lectures: Lectures on gender issues, health, and hygiene, as well as workshops on women's safety, are conducted to sensitize students about critical issues. Collaborations with experts, such as financial education sessions by the National Institute for Securities Markets, provide valuable knowledge for personal and professional growth.
- 4. Leadership and Community Engagement: Female students are encouraged to take leadership roles through their active participation in events. Awareness rallies on themes like Beti Bachao Beti Padhao extend the college's outreach to nearby rural areas, fostering community involvement.

#### **Evidence of Success**

- 1. Enthusiastic Participation: Competitions and workshops witness active participation, with over 100 girls involved in events like self-defense training and skill-building programs.
- 2. Leadership Development: Nine (9) Girl Students of Government College Julana participated in various competitions being held during the International Women's Week being celebrated at Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University
- 3. **Consistent Engagement:** Female students dominate participation in cultural, cocurricular, and leadership activities, showcasing their confidence and involvement in campus life.

#### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

1. Limited Transport Facilities

A lack of transportation options during late hours restricts students' participation in extended activities.

2. Rural Awareness Challenges

Deep-rooted societal norms in rural areas pose challenges for spreading awareness about gender equity and women's rights.

This practice illustrates the institution's commitment to empowering women through education, skills development, and leadership, fostering an environment where students thrive academically and socially.
