- **British Council Digital Library:**
The college has a valid subscription to the British Council Digital Library. This gives students and faculty access to thousands of e-books, audiobooks, magazines, journals, videos, and professional development resources.

- **Reading Room:** A quiet and spacious reading room is available for students to study and refer to books within the library.
