IMPORTANT NOTE

All the Participants/ Contingent In-charges are requested to carefully study the rules and regulations for the various events. In case any objection, regarding any rules being flouted, the matter may be referred to the Jury of Appeals. The objection, if any, should be lodged with the Convener immediately after completion of the concerned event. No protest, whatsoever, shall be entertained on matters regarding the judgment. Decision will be final and binding on all participants. No appeal shall lie against the decision of the Jury of Appeals.

- a) Entry of the teams will be accepted through online registration only at the E-Mail: icculturalfest2023gcjulana@gmail.com
- b) The last date of registration is 25th March, 2023 till 5:00 PM.
- c) The Contingent In-charge will make sure that participants/accompanists will not misbehave with teachers/Judges/Officials.
- d) Entries of the teams must be sent on attached format of Master Entry, Event Entries and Individual Entry Forms.
- e) Photograph of the participants on Individual Entry Form duly attested by the Principal with stamp and signature (See the attachments for Individual Entry Form format).
- f) Entries must be sent from the College official Mail only.
- g) The content should not be vulgar, cheap and objectionable.
- h) Contingent In-charge/Participants must bring their College ID Card with them.
- i) Only 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions will be awarded with the Certificates.
- j) Program will be started at 9:00 AM on 28th March, 2023.

GENERAL RULES FOR DIFFERENT EVENTS

Haryanavi Raagni (Solo)

- a) Each College can send only one Entry.
- b) Duration of competition is 5-7 minutes.
- c) The competition of Raagni will be based on traditional style/ Kissa Raagni/ Social issues only.
- d) Film tune/composition are strictly banned. Only folk music of Haryana in traditional Haryanavi tune is allowed.
- e) Only Four accompanists and either/all folk instruments i.e. Saarang, Been, Nagara, Tasha, Haryanvi Tumba, Gharva, Deru, Bainjo, Clarnet, Chimta, Bansali, Harmonium & Algoja whichever may suit the Raagni are allowed.
- f) Participants must bring their own instruments.

Haryanavi Geet/ Bhajan/ Gazal (Solo)

1. Only one entry per College is allowed.
2. Duration of competition is 3-5 minutes
3. Maximum two accompanists are allowed.
4. Participants must bring their own instruments.
5. The following instruments can be included in Haryanvi Folk Instruments:- Sarangi, Been, Nagara, Tasha, Haryanvi Tumba, Gharva, Deru, Bainjo, Clarnet, Chemta, Bansali, Algoja, and all other instruments which are termed as Haryanvi Folk Instruments.
6. Harmonium is allowed in Gazal.

Haryanvi Solo Dance Male & Female

- a) A college can send one male & one female participant.
- b) Maximum 4 accompanists are allowed.
- c) The dance should be in Haryanvi style and dress.
- d) The duration of the Dance will be 4 to 6 minutes.

Rangoli/Poster Making/On the Spot Painting/Best out of Waste

- a) Only one entry per College is allowed.
- b) Maximum 2 hours 30 minutes will be given to each participant.
- c) A college can send maximum 2 students in its team.
- d) The participants will bring their own material.

Mimicry

1. Only one entry per College is allowed.
2. The duration of performance will be 4 to 5 minutes.
3. Participants may mimic sound of machines, and speeches of well- known persons etc. including film personalities.

Mono Acting

1. Only one entry per College is allowed.
2. The duration of performance will be 4 to 5 minutes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. In this festival all Haryanvi Languages and dialects such as Ahirwati, Mewati, Jattu, Bangaro, Bagri, Korvi, Brij, etc. will be included in Haryanvi Language.
2. The last date for the receipt of entries complete in all respects is 25th March, 2023.
3. You are requested kindly to circulate this programme among the students of your institution and give wide publicity and send the entries of really talented students to participate and compete. The participants must be directed to bring his/her institutional identity card.
4. You are requested to send the name of the Event in which your College will participate. The last date of Entry is 25th March, 2023 till 5:00pm.
5. The teams will compete in the order decided by the organizers.
6. The decision of the Judges will be final.
7. It will be the responsibility of the Contingent In-charge to ensure that the teams report for the various events as per the time and order announced by the organizers to save the valuable time during the function. If any team/individual participant does not turn up according to the scheduled programme, the next team/individual participant will be invited for performance. Such observations will be submitted to the Judgment Panel of the respective event. The team/individual participant not adhering to the scheduled programme strictly, cannot claim the participation as a right.
