## 🌐 Foreign Language Support & Reimbursement Scheme (FLSRS)

### 1. Objective:

In an increasingly globalized world, foreign language proficiency has become a vital skill for students and professionals. As India strengthens its partnerships with countries like Germany, Japan, France, and Italy, the ability to communicate effectively across languages has emerged as a strategic, educational, and economic necessity.

Learning languages such as German, Japanese and other languages equips Indian youth to access international opportunities in education, employment, trade, technology, and cultural exchange.

### 1. Eligibility:

- Must be a resident of Haryana (verified by Parivar Pehchan Patra).
- The candidate must be registered on the HKRNL portal.
- **Applicable for one language/ multiple levels per candidate under this scheme.**
- **Age: 18–45 years.** Minimum qualification: 10th pass or as prescribed by the language program.
- *The Government will bear the cost of youth coming from families whose annual income is up to ₹ 6 lakhs.*
- **Targeted languages:**  
English (IELTS/TOEFL); German; French; Spanish; Italian; Japanese

### 2. Coverage & Financial Assistance:

❖ **The Training & Certification Re-imbursement will be as per the table below:**

Component	Amount/Fee Covered	Conditions
Training Cost Reimbursement	Up to ₹10,000	Reimbursed after passing the language certification exam
Exam Fee Reimbursement	100% of exam fee (Up to maximum limit of ₹20,000)	Fully reimbursed upon passing the certification exam

## Process Flowchart

### 1. Registration

- a. The candidate shall register online, on HKRNL portal

### 2. Training

- a. The candidate shall undergo language training.
- b. The candidate must retain the training fee receipt.
- c. Training may be undertaken in either online or offline mode.
- d. The candidate shall be eligible for reimbursement for only one language.

### 3. Reimbursement Process

- a. The training fee and certification fee shall be reimbursed only after successful completion of the certification.
- b. Upon successful completion of certification, the candidate shall upload the following documents:
  - i. Exam scorecard / language certification
  - ii. Training fee receipt
  - iii. Bank account details for reimbursement
- c. Documents shall be verified by the Scheme Office.
- d. Upon successful verification, reimbursement shall be disbursed as follows:
  - i. Training cost up to ₹10,000 maximum limit of ₹10,000
  - ii. 100% of exam fee, subject to a maximum limit of ₹20,000.
